Medicaid and ARKids First Cards

DHS will mail your card to you. Always carry your card with you. If you do not have your card when you go for medical care, you might have to pay your bill. Do not loan your card to anyone or borrow someone else's card. You may lose your Medicaid eligibility, go to jail or be fined for this.
