**UAMS Walker Family Clinic**

Walker Family Clinic provides outpatient mental health services to adults, ages 18 and up. They offer counseling and psychiatric services in a multidisciplinary team, ***must receive primary care from UAMS to obtain an appointment.*** Medicaid and Private Insurance accepted. Walker Clinic **does not have walk in** clinics. Following intake, **Medicaid patients** will need to obtain a referral for mental health services from their Primary Care Doctor, call Connect Care: 1-800-275-1131 (M-F 8am-4:30pm) if you need a primary care doctor.
